

### **Albany County food pantries.**

Any individual or family in Albany New York can call a food pantry in their area for free groceries, meals, and assistance. The centers will do their best to help individuals get the help they need. That assistance can range from free food, meals, and holiday assistance up through and including clothing or household products.

Free or low cost emergency food boxes, perishable items like meats, fruits, and rice, and hot meals are all distributed by the Albany New York area food banks. Other aid like new or gently used clothing, holiday meals and gifts at Christmas, furniture, baby formula, and more may also be offered, as funding allows. Each non-profit food bank provides items own services to low income families in the county.

Last, but not least, the food pantries can direct people to financial assistance programs and charities in the region. So residents may be able to find electric bill assistance, LIHEAP applications, rent, and housing too. All of this is in addition to the food distributed.
